- 2012 Current ***"Saint John Cruise Ship Terminal Legacy Project"*** designing and executing a 4ft.x8ft. art work done partly in mosaic by the artist and partly in painted tile by children visiting the city from Disney Cruises during the 2012 summer season. A permanent installation in the new terminal and will be unveiled at the official opening of the terminal September 2012.
